SECTION 3: HAZARD INDENTIFICATION



Hazard Statements:

H302: Harmful if swallowed

SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

General Advice: In case of accident or unwellness, seek medical advice immediately (show directions for use or safety data sheet if possible). First Aider: Pay attention to self-protection!

If Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mount. Drink plenty of water if symptoms persist, call a physician.

In Inhaled: If product is inhaled, remove person to fresh air, if not breathing, give artificial respiration. Seek medical attention if breathing problems develop.

If on skin: Remove contamination clothing. Wash skin and hair thoroughly; do two soap and water washings.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

SECTION 5: FIRE FIGHTENING MEASURES

Suitable extinguishing media: Use extinguishing measure that are appropriate to local circumstances and the surrounding environment

Special hazards arising: No Specific hazard known.

Firefighting instructions: Fire fighter should wear full protection gear, including self-contained breathing apparatus. Keep unnecessary people away. If it can be done safely, remove intact containers from the fire. In the event of fire, wear self-contained breathing apparatus. In the event of fire and /or explosion do not breathe fumes.

SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL REALEASE MEASURES

Personal precaution, protective equipment's and emergency procedures: In case of spillage it is important to tale all steps necessary to avoid contact with the spilled material or contaminated surfaces. Extinguish or remove any sources of ignition. When dealing with spills do not eat, drink or smoke. Wear protective clothing and equipment. Keep people and animals away. Prevent spilled material from entering drains or watercourses. **Environmental precautions:** Do-not allow to get into surface water, drains and ground water. If the product

contaminates rived and lakes or drains informal respective authorities.

Reposition any leaking container so as to minimize leakage.

Method and material for contaminates and cleaning up: Contain spill and absorb with earth, sand, clay or other absorbent material. Collect and store in properly labelled, seals drums for safe disposal. Deal with all spillages immediately.
